



Call to artists in visual arts 2016-2017

Support material

The support material you submit is a significant part of your application, is shared with peer assessors, and will have an impact on the assessment of your application as a whole. Choose support material carefully with the aim of presenting your best and most recent work. The material should relate to your proposal and/or demonstrate your ability to complete your project.

You must fill out a list of the support material and be sure that this list corresponds with the items (cf. form "List of the works").

Material not accepted:

- Original artworks
- MAC format files that are not fully PC compatible
- Support material embedded in documents (Word, PowerPoint, PDF, etc.)
- Compressed files (WinZip, Stuffit, etc.)
- USB thumb drives or media cards
- Material that requires third-party software, plug-ins, extensions or other executables that need to be downloaded and installed
- Material accessed on websites
- Real Media files
- Slides

The proposal and all supporting material must be submitted together by the deadline dates.

The requests must be sent by mail and must be postmarked by due date.
